# I. God's Justice - Biblical Justice

### Justice in the Old Testament

#### Mishpat

To treat people equitably

Acquitting or punishing persons on the merits of the case, regardless of race or social status

Giving people their due, punishment or protection

Deuteronomy 18

Rectifying

#### Tzedakah

Being just, righteous, declaring a person right

Life of right relationships

Day-to-day living in family, society, with fairness, generosity and equity

Living right with God, leading to righteous social life

#### Psalm 82

God is the ultimate Judge

God will administer justice in his courtroom of perfect justice

God's righteousness is the standard of justice

God appoints people to administer his justice

God does not overlook wickedness of judges/societies

God deeply cares for the weak, orphans, the needy, the powerless

God reigns over all the earth, He's Got It!

#### A. God's Justice Displays His Righteousness

Deuteronomy 32:4

The Rock, his work is perfect, for all his ways are just; he is a faithful God, and without injustice; righteous and upright is he.

#### B. God Acts with Justice

Psalm 9:6

The LORD is known by his acts of *justice*; the wicked are ensnared by the work of their hands.

#### C. God's Justice is Exercised Fairly and Equitably

Psalm 9:7-8

But Yahweh sits enthroned forever. He has established his throne for judgment. And he will judge the world with righteousness. He will judge the peoples with <u>equity</u>.

#### He judges people according to their deeds

#### Revelation 20:12-13, 22:12

He punishes wickedness

2 Thessalonians 1:8–9

...with burning flame giving punishment to those who do not know God and who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus, who will pay the penalty of eternal destruction, away from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of his strength,

He rewards righteousness

2 Timothy 4:8

Finally, the *crown of righteousness* is reserved for me, that the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day, and not only to me, but also to all who have loved his appearing.

#### D. God Establishes Justice

Psalm 45:6, 89:14

Your throne, O God, will last for ever and ever; a scepter of *justice* will be the scepter of your kingdom.

Righteousness and *justice* are the foundation of your throne; love and faithfulness go before you.

#### He upholds the cause of the oppressed

Isaiah 61:8

For I, Yahweh, *love justice*, hate robbery and injustice, and I will faithfully give their reward, and I will make an everlasting covenant with them.

He vindicates those who have been wronged

Romans 12:19

Do not take revenge yourselves, dear friends, but give place to God's wrath, for it is written, "Vengeance is mine, *I will repay*," says the Lord. He is completely impartial

Ephesians 6:9

And masters, do the same things to them, giving up threats, knowing that both their Lord and yours is in heaven, and there is <u>no partiality</u> with him.

#### E. God's Ways in Exercising Justice

Ecclesiastes 7:15

I have seen all these things in my vain life: Sometimes a righteous man perishes in spite of his righteousness, and sometimes a wicked man lives a long life in spite of his evil.

#### He warns before punishing

Hebrews 12:25

Watch out that you do not refuse the one who is speaking! For if those did not escape when they refused the one who warned them on earth, much less will we escape, if we reject the one <u>who warns</u> from heaven,

He gives opportunity for people to repent

1 John 1:9

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just, so that <u>he will forgive</u> us our sins and will cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

# Article 15: The Christian and Social Order Baptist Faith and Message, 2000

All Christians are under obligation to seek to make the will of Christ supreme in our own lives and in human society. Means and methods used for the improvement of society and the establishment of righteousness among men can be truly and permanently helpful only when they are rooted in the regeneration of the individual by the saving grace of God in Jesus Christ. In the spirit of Christ, Christians should oppose racism, every form of greed, selfishness, and vice, and all forms of sexual immorality, including adultery, homosexuality, and pornography. We should work to provide for the orphaned, the needy, the abused, the aged, the helpless, and the sick.

#### Article 15: The Christian and Social Order

We should speak on behalf of the unborn and contend for the sanctity of all human life from conception to natural death. Every Christian should seek to bring industry, government, and society as a whole under the sway of the principles of righteousness, truth, and brotherly love. In order to promote these ends Christians should be ready to work with all men of good will in any good cause, always being careful to act in the spirit of love without compromising their loyalty to Christ and His truth.
