4. If we rightly understood vs. 27, how would that change how we approach people? How would that change how we interact with people?

5. What is the benefit of quoting extrabiblical sources for Paul? How would you use this technique in your own conversations?

6. Why does Paul include "repentance" and "Judgement" in vs 30 and 31 as part of his message? What's the point and purpose?

7. Though this is not a template for evangelism, there are many beneficial notes of truth embedded in Paul's message. What are some that stuck out to you?
