Encourage one another means get _____ involved

Your spiritual business is somebody else's spiritual business. I haven't called you to mind your own business, I've called you to mind one another's business because I don't want anybody to get into this trap of slowly <u>drifting</u> from God.

Everyone has the potential to <u>drift</u>. And the responsibility to keep one another from drifting is a <u>group</u> thing.

Behind the trap is the deceitfulness of ________

The purpose of encouragement/warning is that none of you may be ______ by sin's deceitfulness.

Encourage means to appeal, to <u>beg</u>, to urge, to exhort. To do this is always <u>awkward</u>. But, it's part of your role in the Body of Christ. You're not called to be a lone ranger Christian. We're connected so that leads me to ask you two questions.

1. What Christian do you know that has started down that path?

2. Who in your circle feels free and empowered to come rushing in when they see you beginning to drift?

Summary: Keep your <u>eyes</u> open for others, keep your <u>life</u> open to others, and keep your <u>heart</u> soft toward God.
